I DON'T WANT THE CITY TO BE THE ONES TO BUILD THE CARS, BUT I WOULD LIKE TO ENCOURAGE WITH TAX INCENTIVE AND OTHER INCENTIVES FOR ENTREPRENEURS TO DEVELOP ALTERNATIVE STYLE CARS, ALTERNATIVE FUEL ENERGY CARS AND JUST BRING CAR MANUFACTURING BACK TO SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA.

I LIVE IN THE SAN FERNANDO VALLEY NEAR THE FORMER GENERAL MOTORS PLANT, WHERE I KNOW THERE WAS A LOT HIGH PAYING MANUFACTURING JOBS THAT WENT AWAY WHEN GENERAL MOTORS CLOSED THAT PLANT.
