Hi, my name is Wendy Lyons. I am a longtime Socialist and have worked as a meatpacker and garment worker.

The bipartisan escalation of the U.S. war in Iraq serves only the ruling rich. A multi-theater war is now unfolding around the world These military assaults are an extension of a developing war on the working class at home—from factory raids and deportations to murders by the police in working class neighborhoods, to attacks on social services and democratic rights.

My campaign calls for

- Bring All the U.S. Troops Home Now! Out of Iraq. And all over the world. Stop the threats against Iran! Not one penny, not one person for imperialist wars!
- Strengthen unions and organize them where they don't exist to unite and defend workers. We need to use the collective power of workers like the May 1 boycott for immigrant rights or the example of Smithfield packing

workers who walked off the job to protest firings of immigrant workers and to demand the company recognize MLK day as a holiday.

- For a public works program to put people to work at union wages building the things we need, like low cost housing, schools, hospitals, mass transit.
- For extending social security to cover lifetime health benefits
- Fight police brutality. No to anti-gang measures that only strengthen the "gang in blue." Jail killer cops.
- No to social security checks in the workplace. No to deportations and raids. Legalize immigrant workers now!
- Defend affirmative action. Blacks have double the rate of white unemployment in Los Angeles and only 96 African-American students were admitted into UCLA this fall.
- No to the high school exit exam that denies students diplomas. Halt school lockdowns.
- Defend women's right to choose abortion.

 Hands off Cuba and Venezuela. Cuba, where working people took power into their own hands stands as an example.

We need to build a revolutionary movement that will lead a fight by working people to take power out of the hands of the ruling billionaire class and establish a workers and farmers government.
