All candidates have the option of submitting a Candidate Statement as part of their Candidate Filing Packet. Every candidate must adhere to the following guidelines when submitting a Candidate Statement:

- Must fit in the designated area below;
- Must not exceed 150 word count limit;
- Must be at least 12-point font (if typed);
- Must be submitted no later than April 13, 2010; and,
- May not include any pictures, profanity or comments about any other candidate.

Additionally, a candidate may submit translated version(s) of the original statement, which must comply with all aforementioned criteria. Candidate Statements will be posted on the City Clerk's website and at the polling place on Election Day.

I am a member of the National Association of Parliamentarians and serve on the boards of several non-profit cooperations.

I was elected to OPNC in the 2008 (June) elections as an East Representative.

I served as OPNC Treasurer March 2009 - present. Monthly reports to the Board include: 1. Income and Expenses, 2. Monthly expenses with YTD totals and current budget comparisons.

I made quarterly reports to DONE in a timely manner to reconcile our petty cash and credit card expenditures.

I did an annual assets inventory within the DONE time and content guidelines.

I was chair of the Budget, Finance and Funding committee and held meetings in April, May and June. The meetings set neighborhood grant funding guidelines, reviewed any neighborhood grant applications making Board recommendations, and created a detailed 2009 -10 OPNC budget.

As a member of the executive committee, attended the BONC hearings to reduce OPNC quorum.
