All candidates have the option of submitting a Candidate Statement as part of their Candidate Filing Packet. Every candidate must adhere to the following guidelines when submitting a Candidate Statement:

- Must fit in the designated area below;
- Must not exceed 150 word count limit;
- Must be at least 12-point font (if typed);
- Must be submitted no later than April 13, 2010; and,
- May not include any pictures, profanity or comments about any other candidate.

Additionally, a candidate may submit translated version(s) of the original statement, which must comply with all aforementioned criteria. Candidate Statements will be posted on the City Clerk's website and at the polling place on Election Day.

As one of your MCWCC At-Large Representatives for the past two years, I've worked to represent the full range of people and neighborhoods that make this district unique.

My family and I live in the southeastern portion of MCWCC (near Park La Brea and the Westside JCC), and our previous home was near another section of the district (West Hollywood). I work in the district, and we dine, shop and use the parks, museums and other cultural attractions here.
