Neighborhood Council Elections

General Information

The City Clerk was not provided with funds in the City's 2011-2012 Budget to conduct the 2012 Neighborhood Council (NC) Elections, and NC Elections as administered by the City Clerk were postponed until 2014.

The City Clerk was instructed by the City Council to perform a study on alternative methods for conducting NC Elections. The purpose of this study was to ascertain what each NC's preferences are for conducting NC elections, and to lay out all options for the City Council and Mayor to review. The NC Election Alternatives Survey Report, containing a summary of this study, is now available to read.
