REGISTER TO VOTE IF YOU ARE:



United States citizen



18+ on or before Election Day



Not in prison for a felony (State paroles are allowed to register and VOTE!)



Not currently found mentally incompetent to vote by a court

PRE-register to vote if you're a U.S. citizen and 16 or 17 and be ready to vote when you turn 18.

ALL active CA voters registered by the voter registration deadline will be sent a Vote-By-Mail ballot.

*Must be postmarked by Election Day and received within 7 days to be accepted.


IN-PERSON VOTING ALSO AVAILABLE


