I will invest in programs such as a Neighborhood Law Corps - which is like a cross between the Peace Corps and Legal Aid - in order to improve the City’s responsiveness to its constituents and the safety of our neighborhoods. I’ll cut through red tape to simplify doing business with and in our City.

I was born and raised in San Juan Puerto Rico – saludos a mi pueblo y comunidades latinas a través de todos Los Angeles and have called Los Angeles home since 1982. I am a lifelong pro choice feminist and would be the first woman elected City Attorney.
