All candidates have the option of submitting a Candidate Statement as part of their Candidate Filing Packet. Every candidate must adhere to the following guidelines when submitting a Candidate Statement.

- Must fit in the designated area below;
- Must not exceed 150 words in length;
- Must be at least 12-point font in type;
- Must be submitted no later than February 1, 2010; and
- May not contain any signatures, promises or commitments about any other candidates.

Additionally, a candidate may submit translated versions of the original statement, which must comply with all aforementioned criteria. Candidate Statements will be posted on the City Clerk's website and at the polling place on Election Day.
