NIKE RUN HIT WONDER

**Subject**

Motion - On Sunday, September 24, 2006, Nike will be sponsoring the Nike Run Hit Wonder. This 5K and 10K running race will benefit LA LEGGERS and NikeGo, both 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations which promote physical and mental health through running and walking. The event will consist of the race along with free concert at the end. This philanthropic community event is expected to attract over 20,000 participants throughout the community. The Eighth Council District has received a request that the City provide certain services to facilitate the event and declare the function a Special Event. Approval of this request will mean that an estimated \$20,000 in fees and salary costs will be absorbed by the City. THEREFORE MOVE that the Nike Run Hit Wonder on Sunday, September 24, 2006, be declared a Special Event, and that all City departments be requested to waive all fees, costs, and requirements, except insurance and application requirements. FURTHER MOVE that pursuant to Ordinance No. 150567 relating to Temporary Street Closures that the following closures be made on Sunday, September 24, 2006, from 5:00 AM to 10:00 AM, (local and emergency access must be maintained at all times) subject to the supervision of the Director of the Bureau of Street Services: \* South Figueroa Street between West Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard and West Venice Boulevard \* West 28th Street between South Figueroa Street and South Hoover Street \* South Hoover Street between West 28th Street and West Jefferson Boulevard \* West Jefferson Boulevard between South Hoover Street and South Vermont Avenue \* South Vermont Avenue between West Jefferson Boulevard and West Exposition Boulevard \* West Exposition Boulevard between South Vermont Avenue and South Menlo Avenue \* South Menlo Avenue from West Exposition Boulevard and West Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation post "Temporary No Parking" signs from 7:00 AM on Saturday, September 23, 2006 through 2:00 PM on Sunday, September 24, 2006 on the following streets to facilitate the set-up and tear-down of stages that will be utilized along the course: \* 37th Place between South Figueroa Street and South Flower Street \* University Avenue between 28th Street and 30th Street FURTHER MOVE that those streets comprising the route of the run/walk be opened for public use on a "rolling" basis, subject to the supervision of the Department of Transportation. FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Street Services be directed to furnish the necessary traffic control devices. These devices will be provided with the understanding that the sponsoring organization will pick up and return them to the Bureau. FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation be directed to post "Temporary No Stopping" signs on the affected streets and provide traffic control personnel, as required. FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation and the Los Angeles Police Department be authorized to close any streets, at their discretion, that are necessary to facilitate public safety and traffic flow during this event. FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Sanitation be directed to provide appropriate containers, receptacles and bins for refuse and recycling collection along the route and assist with the removing of materials collected as requested by the event organizer. FURTHER MOVE that the Los Angeles Police Department, the Los Angeles Fire Department, the Bureau of Street Services and the General Services Department be instructed to provide assistance as requested by the Event Coordinator. FURTHER MOVE that should unforeseen circumstances change the actual date of the Special Event, the aforementioned departmental instructions continue to apply. OLD COUNCIL FILE NO. 03-0142
