

1 pursuant to Section 9 of the Central City West
2 Specific Plan and any other money appropriated or
3 given to this Fund for the mitigation of
4 transportation impacts throughout the Central City
5 West Specific Plan area. Two percent of all fees
6 collected pursuant to the Central City West Specific
7 Plan shall be transferred each year to the
8 Department of Transportation, two percent
9 transferred each year to the Department of City
10 Planning and one percent transferred each year to
11 the Department of Public Works, Bureau of
12 Engineering for administering the Specific Plan.

13 C. All interest or other earnings from money
14 received into the Fund shall be credited to the Fund
15 and devoted to the purposes set forth herein.

16 D. The Department of Transportation shall
17 collect fees pursuant to Subsection C of Section 9
18 of the Central City West Specific Plan and remit all
19 such fees to the Treasurer's Office for deposit into
20 the Fund.

21 E. All monies from the Fund shall be expended
22 only as provided in Section 9 of the Central City
23 West Specific Plan and pursuant to the following
24 restrictions:

25 1. Up to five percent of the revenues
26 placed in the Fund each year shall be used for
27 administrative expenditures, including staff

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from the Department of City Planning, Department of Transportation and Department of Public Works, Bureau of Engineering.

2. Up to 17 percent of the revenues placed in the Fund each year shall be used for local street improvements, such as the enhancement of the computerized signalization system and the widening of the streets.

3. Up to 15 percent of the revenues placed in the Fund each year shall be used for the acquisition of rights-of-way for construction of transportation improvements.

4. Up to 25 percent of the revenues placed in the Fund each year shall be used for regional freeway improvements such as additional ramps on the Harbor and Hollywood freeways.

5. Up to 38 percent of the revenues placed in the Fund each year shall be used for transit improvements, such as a new Metro Rail transit station.

6. If a Community Facilities District is established to fund a specific transportation improvement or improvements, then money from the Fund which is allocated for that specific transportation improvement or improvements may be transferred to the Community Facilities

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and cause the same to be published by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles, to wit: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the City Hall of the City of Los Angeles; one copy on the bulletin board located at the east entrance to the Hall of Justice in said City; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Hall of Records in the said City.

DECLARATION OF POSTING ORDINANCE
