An ordinance adding Section 41.47.2 to the Los Angeles Municipal Code to prohibit urinating or defecating in public except in approved locations

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Article 1 of Chapter IV of the Los Angeles Code is hereby amended to add Section 41.47.2, said section to read:

SEC. 41.47.2. URINATING OR DEFECATING IN PUBLIC.

No person shall urinate or defecate in or upon any public street, sidewalk, alley, plaza, beach, park, public building or other publicly maintained facility or place, or in any place open to the public or exposed to public view, except when using a urinal, toilet or commode located in a restroom, or when using a portable or temporary toilet or other facility designed for the sanitary disposal of human waste and which is enclosed from public view.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and cause the same to be published in some daily newspaper printed and published in the City of Los Angeles.



DECLARATION OF POSTING ORDINANCE



**PUBLIC SAFETY and PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEES' REPORT and ORDINANCE
FIRST CONSIDERATION** relative to prohibiting urinating or defecating in public.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Bernson - Chick):

1. **PRESENT and ADOPT** the accompanying ORDINANCE adding Section 41.47.2 to the Los Angeles Municipal Code to prohibit urinating or defecating in public except in approved locations.
2. **INSTRUCT** the Department of Public Works to report back to the Public Safety Committee within 45 days regarding options and costs for public toilets and strategic locations. The Department should include Business Improvement Districts, Metropolitan Transit Authority and other interested groups in the discussion and development of recommendations.
3. **RECEIVE and FILE** the Public Safety Committee report dated February 28, 2000, inasmuch as this report supersedes that report.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer (CAO) nor the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

On March 15, 2000, City Council considered a report from the Public Safety (PS) Committee, dated February 28, 2000, relative to adding a section to the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to prohibit urinating or defecating in public. The matter was continued, in Council, to a variety of dates, and then on August 9, 2000, was referred to the Public Works Committee for further consideration.

The PS Committee report stated that the City Attorney's Office consulted with several municipalities which have enacted similar ordinances that prohibit urinating or defecating in public. The other municipalities report no unusual difficulties in enforcing its regulation. Under this Ordinance, no person would be allowed to urinate or defecate in or upon any public street, sidewalk, alley, plaza, beach, park, public building or other publically maintained facility or place, or in any place open to the public or exposed to public view,

except when using a urinal, toilet or commode located in a restroom, or when using a portable or temporary toilet or other facility designed for the sanitary disposal of human waste and which is enclosed from public view. The Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) would be the enforcement agency for this new ordinance. Enforcement would be accomplished by means of physical booking or use of existing Release From Custody guidelines.

The City Attorney reports that the violation could be prosecuted as either a misdemeanor or an infraction. The Board of Police Commissioners (Board), on February 15, 2000, approved the proposed draft ordinance. The PS Committee, at a special meeting on February 28, 2000, considered this matter and recommended approval of the ordinance and also requested that the Department of Public Works report back with options and costs for public toilets, etc.

On October 8, 2003, the Public Works Committee discussed this matter with City staff and received public testimony from business owners, residents and the LAPD, in support of the proposed Ordinance. The City Attorney reported that Los Angeles is one of the very few cities that has not adopted such an Ordinance. The Ordinance was created to give law enforcement the ability to cite someone for public urination or defecation as an infraction or as a misdemeanor violation. Previously, law enforcement had used a littering infraction to enforce this, but the court deemed this an inappropriate use of the statute. The City Attorney, in 2000, advised the Council that unless there were public toilets available for people to use, it would be difficult to successfully prosecute these violations because of the affirmative defense of necessity. The matter was held in order to attach the Ordinance's approval to the automated toilet program. Unfortunately, the planning of the toilets' locations is taking longer than anticipated. Both the City Attorney and LAPD feel that the Ordinance should move forward at this time. The City Attorney has indicated that they will work with the LAPD to assure that they are only citing people in locations where public toilets are available, and the individuals choose not to use them.

The Public Works Committee concurred with the original recommendations of the PS Committee from the February 28, 2000 meeting. This matter is now being forwarded to Council for consideration.



RE: OPPOSITION to Public Urination Ordinance: DOCID 99-1442

While the Los Angeles Coalition to End Hunger & Homelessness does not condone public urination and/or defecation, we feel that the proposed ordinance by Council members Bernson and Chick is "many clean public toilets late and tens of thousands of dollars short" on addressing the public health crisis in Skid Row and around the City of Los Angeles.

We must continue to resist putting on a good face for the Democratic National Convention [DNC] while trampling on the civil rights of thousands of our most vulnerable citizens. If we really want to impress the DNC delegates, we would be better served to locate affordable housing for the thousands that have no homes, rather than criminalizing their behavior that is a product of decades of neglect. We can not continue to care about homeless people only when the big show comes to town. We harassed homeless people when the Olympics came to town. We harassed homeless people when the Pope came to town. To do so a third time only serves to shine a light on our failed approach to those most in need.

The proposed ordinance is defective for the following 3 key reasons:

1. ***The ordinance is punitive and short sighted:*** It is extremely punitive and short sighted to have public toilets in the downtown area that are poorly maintained and verge on a health hazard on their own, blame homeless people for not using them because they are disgusting, and then citing them for using the only alternative open to them, the streets and alleys of our community.

We agree with Jess Markey [operator of a print shop on Crocker Street], as quoted in the recent LA Times article "Befouled Businesses Near L.A.'s Skid Row Seek Relief in the Law," "The street is not a toilet. It is that simple." However, we would add, "The street is not a home. It is that simple."

Working to eliminate hunger and homelessness through public education, technical assistance, public policy analysis, advocacy, organizing, and community action.

Before making "*natures call due to lack of public alternatives a crime*," it would seem that all alternatives should be explored first. The current ordinance puts public health solutions behind the private wishes of the business community and certainly behind the public necessity of people without options, due to the failure of the City to keep these toilets clean and usable.

3. ***Criminalizing one of the most basic bodily functions hurts many and is only a symbolic victory for a few:***

A daily bodily function common to all humanity is a crime punishable by fines as high as \$1,000 and up to six months in jail?

While we understand the urge to legislate public urination and/or defecation as a misdemeanor, the end result is that we criminalize behavior that for housed people is a daily occurrence. But, for homeless people, a fine that can not be paid, and or time in jail, means a record that prevents finding a job or getting a drivers license that can lead to employment.

The ultimate irony is that if this ordinance succeeds, we will have only succeeded in outlawing every bodily function for homeless people. Feeding homeless people is already a crime in many parts of the state. Sleeping in open spaces is already a crime in many parts of the state. Eating, sleeping and disposal of waste. What else can we add to this list to further dehumanize homeless people?

In the long run, is this the result we want to achieve? Do we really expect people in "Skid Row" to "hold it" to avoid a fine or time in jail while the City provides no decent alternative?

Clearly the answer is NO!

This ordinance is punitive, short-sighted and will do little to address the public health issues raised by this debate.

Instead, LACEH&H suggests four common sense alternatives:


- 1. Do not vote for this ordinance. Instead....**
- 2. UNLOCK THE PUBLIC BATHROOMS THAT CURRENTLY EXIST: The City of Los Angeles must insist that all publicly funded buildings provide public accommodations to homeless people who need to use a restroom. Examples would include the Community Development Development building, the Community Redevelopment Agency parking garages and buildings supported by CRA funds, and all the social service programs that receive public funding.**
- 3. In the short term, instruct the Dept. of Public Works to maintain CLEAN public toilets in Los Angeles City**
- 4. In the short term, instruct the Dept. of Public Works to install some public toilets that meet ADA requirements**
- 5. Longer term, the City must construct public restrooms that are ADA compliant and well maintained, and/or invest in European-style "self-cleaning" public restrooms.**

The City Council is on the right road by recently funding a Housing Trust Fund. We must find long term, permanent solutions to ending homelessness in our community, rather than deferring to the common practice of criminalizing the behavior and then wondering why nothing has changed while there has been an increase in the number of homeless people with arrest records. Pandering to short term "fixes" only serves to squander resources for long term solutions.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Public Safety Committee instructed the Bureau of Street Services through the Board of Public Works to report back on various options and costs associated with the placement of public toilets throughout the City. Twelve U.S. cities were contacted but only eight cities and a regional governing entity responded in time to be included in the survey results. The following options are submitted for your committee's review and consideration:

- ◆ Purchase of the automated self-cleaning public pay toilets at a cost ranging from \$150,000 to \$250,000 per unit with an additional maintenance cost of approximately \$50,000 per unit per year.
- ◆ Long-term lease of the units at a cost ranging from \$60,000 to \$75,000 per unit per year.
- ◆ Long-term lease of the units at no cost to the City with the program costs being offset by advertising revenue generated through the installation of advertising kiosks or panels throughout the City.
- ◆ Install a limited number of advertising kiosks/panels to partially offset the cost of the program with some other funding source used to offset the remaining costs of the program.
- ◆ Continue and expand the existing program allowing the placement of portable chemical toilets in the public right-of-way throughout the City.
- ◆ Incorporate automated self-cleaning public pay toilets into a larger "integrated street furniture" program that includes transit shelters, news racks, news stand kiosks, advertising kiosks/panels, bus benches, trash receptacles, information kiosks, etc. after current transit shelter and bus bench contracts have expired.
- ◆ Piggyback onto existing Los Angeles Metropolitan Transportation Authority - Automated Public Toilet Program contract.
- ◆ Do nothing at this time.

BACKGROUND

The City of Los Angeles, like a growing number of other municipalities, must consider the problem of homeless persons urinating and defecating in public because there are too few public restroom facilities to serve them, as well as increasing number of tourists and residents who may be in need of a comfort station. Without adequate facilities, areas can become fouled, blighted and lead to urban decay. This problem has escalated in recent years in Los Angeles creating health hazards in some areas and requiring special cleaning action by City forces. In order to prevent a serious health risk to the public or reduce the possibility of contamination to the States natural waters, the Board of Public Works on June 22, 1994, adopted a joint Board Report from the Bureaus of Street Services and Engineering recommending the placement of 26 portable toilets on public sidewalks at various locations in the downtown skid row area. These toilets are still serving homeless and underhoused individuals, even though some businesses oppose their placement because of the negative affects of large groups of individuals living on the streets.

In contrast, public pay toilets serving tourists and residents alike appear to have gained wide acceptance in Europe, virtually eliminating the obnoxious odors that have plagued many European cities in recent years. More recently the cities of San Francisco, San Jose, Palo Alto, and Boston have implemented public pay toilet programs. San Francisco is offsetting the cost of the program by allowing the contractor to install and sell advertising on freestanding kiosks at a 4.5 to 1 ratio of ad panels to toilets. The revenue generated from the ad panels defrays the costs of installation and maintenance and may even generate a profit for the contractor.

Boston has included their public pay toilets as part of an integrated streetscape program that includes transit shelters, information kiosks, news boxes, news racks, trash receptacles and freestanding advertising panels that generate the revenue to cover the cost of the program. San Jose and Palo Alto have twenty year lease agreements for the installation and maintenance of public pay toilets throughout their cities. These California cities are leasing these units for \$61,511 per year per unit but are also responsible for construction related costs. No advertising is allowed on their toilets. The Los Angeles Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) in November 1999 signed a ten-year agreement with Omni Outdoor for the installation and maintenance of ten (10) automated self-cleaning public toilets and fifty-four (54) advertising kiosk located on MTA property. The advertising revenues are intended to pay for the program. The Bureau is currently exploring the feasibility of piggybacking onto their contract.

VENDOR SELECTION

A successful public pay toilet program must address several key issues public safety/security, accommodating physically challenged individuals, identifying revenue/funding sources and legal issues concerning changing the City's longstanding policy banning freestanding advertising panels in the public right-of-way. The City must select an experienced vendor who can maximize public accommodations through strategic selection of sites based upon community need and controlled program costs while ensuring the delivery of a high quality public service.

On Wednesday, March 29, 2000, the Board of Public Works Commissioner Fleming instructed the Bureau of Street Services to conduct a survey to determine what types of pay toilet programs are used by other cities. The Bureau surveyed twelve (12) cities throughout the United States, plus the regional governing entity Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA). Eight cities responded to the Bureau's survey. The cities of Boston, San Francisco, Palo Alto and San Jose are the only United States cities currently using automated pay toilets. The MTA hopes to have their pay toilets installed by August, 2000, but no later than December, 2000.

CITIES SURVEYED

The Bureau's survey responses and contacts with manufacturers of automated restroom facilities resulted the following list of cities concerned with providing automated self-cleaning public toilets to residents. The cities of Atlanta, Long Beach, Miami and Washington D.C. did not respond in the time provided for our survey. The following is a summary of the survey findings:

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to adding Section 41.47.2 to the Los Angeles Municipal Code to prohibit urinating or defecating in public.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Bernson - Chick):

1. PRESENT and ADOPT accompanying ORDINANCE adding Section 41.47.2 to the Los Angeles Municipal Code to prohibit urinating or defecating in public except in approved locations.
2. INSTRUCT the Department of Public Works to report back to the Public Safety Committee within 45 days regarding options and costs for public toilets and strategic locations. The Department should include Business Improvement Districts, Metropolitan Transit Authority and other interested groups in the discussion and development of recommendations.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

The City Attorney's Office has consulted with several municipalities which have enacted similar ordinances that prohibit urinating or defecating in public. The other municipalities report no unusual difficulties in enforcing its regulation.

Under the ordinance, no person would be allowed to urinate or defecate in or upon any public street, sidewalk, alley, plaza, beach, park, public building or other publicly maintained facility or place, or in any place open to the public or exposed to public view, except when using a urinal, toilet or commode located in a restroom, or when using a portable or temporary toilet or other facility designed for the sanitary disposal of human waste and which is enclosed from public view.

The Los Angeles Police Department would be the enforcement agency for this new ordinance. Enforcement would be accomplished by means of physical booking or use of existing Release From Custody guidelines.

The City Attorney reports that the violation could be prosecuted as either a misdemeanor or an infraction. Section 11.00 (m) of the LAMC provides, "Any violation of this Code that is designated as a misdemeanor, may be charged by the City Attorney as either a misdemeanor or an infraction."

The Board of Police Commissioners at its February 15, 2000 meeting, approved the proposed draft ordinance. At a special meeting held February 28, 2000, the Public Safety Committee considered the proposed draft ordinance. Representatives from the Historic Core, the Fashion District and Central City East Association all spoke in support of the proposed ordinance. Councilmember Pacheco stated that even though the makers of the Motion are from the Valley, this is a Citywide issue. The Committee recommended approval of the ordinance and additionally requested the Department of Public Works to report back within 45 days on options and costs for public toilets and to include BID's, MTA and any other interested groups in the discussion and development of recommendations. The Committee now forwards the matter to the Council for its consideration.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to adding Section 41.47.2 to the Los Angeles Municipal Code to prohibit urinating or defecating in public.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Bernson - Chick):

1. PRESENT and ADOPT accompanying ORDINANCE adding Section 41.47.2 to the Los Angeles Municipal Code to prohibit urinating or defecating in public except in approved locations.
2. INSTRUCT the Department of Public Works to report back to the Public Safety Committee within 45 days regarding options and costs for public toilets and strategic locations. The Department should include Business Improvement Districts, Metropolitan Transit Authority and other interested groups in the discussion and development of recommendations.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

The City Attorney's Office has consulted with several municipalities which have enacted similar ordinances that prohibit urinating or defecating in public. The other municipalities report no unusual difficulties in enforcing its regulation.

Under the ordinance, no person would be allowed to urinate or defecate in or upon any public street, sidewalk, alley, plaza, beach, park, public building or other publicly maintained facility or place, or in any place open to the public or exposed to public view, except when using a urinal, toilet or commode located in a restroom, or when using a portable or temporary toilet or other facility designed for the sanitary disposal of human waste and which is enclosed from public view.

The Los Angeles Police Department would be the enforcement agency for this new ordinance. Enforcement would be accomplished by means of physical booking or use of existing Release From Custody guidelines.

The City Attorney reports that the violation could be prosecuted as either a misdemeanor or an infraction. Section 11.00 (m) of the LAMC provides, "Any violation of this Code that is designated as a misdemeanor, may be charged by the City Attorney as either a misdemeanor or an infraction."

The Board of Police Commissioners at its February 15, 2000 meeting, approved the proposed draft ordinance. At a special meeting held February 28, 2000, the Public Safety Committee considered the proposed draft ordinance. Representatives from the Historic Core, the Fashion District and Central City East Association all spoke in support of the proposed ordinance. Councilmember Pacheco stated that even though the makers of the Motion are from the Valley, this is a Citywide issue. The Committee recommended approval of the ordinance and additionally requested the Department of Public Works to report back within 45 days on options and costs for public toilets and to include BID's, MTA and any other interested groups in the discussion and development of recommendations. The Committee now forwards the matter to the Council for its consideration.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Article 1 of Chapter IV of the Los Angeles Code is hereby amended to add Section 41.47.2, said section to read:

SEC. 41.47.2. URINATING OR DEFECATING IN PUBLIC.

No person shall urinate or defecate in or upon any public street, sidewalk, alley, plaza, beach, park, public building or other publicly maintained facility or place, or in any place open to the public or exposed to public view, except when using a urinal, toilet or commode located in a restroom, or when using a portable or temporary toilet or other facility designed for the sanitary disposal of human waste and which is enclosed from public view.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and cause the same to be published in some daily newspaper printed and published in the City of Los Angeles.





Disturbingly, the City is experiencing more and more instances of people urinating in public; on streets, on others' private property and in our parks and other open spaces. At a time when we are celebrating our premier position as a world class city, host to thousands of tourists and numerous conventions we cannot permit this practice to proliferate.
