Comments for Public Posting: Sanitation issues When animals are kept in overcrowded cages or pens, slaughtered and dressed in live market areas, these areas become contaminated with body fluids, feces and other waste, increasing the risk of transmission of pathogens to workers and customers and potentially resulting in spill over of pathogens to other animals in the market. Such environments provide the opportunity for animal viruses, including coronaviruses, to amplify themselves and transmit to new hosts, including humans. Animals at these markets are in cages that are stacked one over another. Animals at the bottom are often soaked with all kinds of liquid. Animal excrement, pus, blood and urine. Such conditions allow viruses to spread from one animal to another as well as to humans who come into contact with them.
