Comments for Public Posting: Public health concern: I'm writing with serious concerns about the lack of accessible water at the LA County Fair in Pomona. In 90+ degree heat, vendors refused to provide a cup of ice to cool down our water—saying they couldn't give us a cup due to inventory. Yet when I presented my own cup for ice, they still refused. I stopped at multiple stands, yet no one mentioned the availability of indoor water stations. This is a public health risk. We also witnessed a medical emergency during within a few hours of opening, which highlights the urgent need for clearly marked hydration stations and more compassionate, humane water policies. Please take immediate steps to ensure safe, visible access to water for all attendees—especially young children. If LA County can pull an event like this together, it can clearly afford to double it's cups inventory.
