Comments for Public Posting: Request for Safety at San Pedro Street Elementary Hello, my name is Tara De Dios and I'm the school nurse at San Pedro Street Elementary. I'm asking the city to please consider adding school speed signs and speed bumps on our main drop-off and pick-up streets, San Pedro Street and Trinity Street. Our school is right off the 10 freeway and also on a very busy street where cars move fast all day. Every morning and afternoon, I see students and families trying to cross while cars speed through. It's dangerous, especially for our students who walk to and from school. Speed bumps and clear signs would slow traffic down and make it safer. I have read about the city and LAUSD already working together last school year to add 250 speed bumps near 92 schools. We just want our school to be next. LADOT's Safe Routes to School program says it best: traffic crashes are the leading cause of death for children ages 2 to 14 in Los Angeles. That's heartbreaking, and it's something we can help prevent. Please make San Pedro Street Elementary a priority for these safety improvements. Our kids and families deserve safe routes to school.
