Comments for Public Posting: I live on a street in Woodland Hills. For over 6 years I have tried to get Councilman's Blumenfield's office to follow up on my request to get my street paved. My neighbor has been trying to do the same since the Northridge earthquake! His office responds to my emails and then either gives me excuses or says they will follow up. One time I received a follow up email two years after I sent one. The excuses I have received have been numerous. Here are just a few: your street is too steep, your street doesn't exist on city records, your street is in too bad of a condition so we can't prioritize it. I have sent pictures and so many emails, while the streets to each side of us get paved every other year. It's not right to be denied this basic city service for over 25 years! I gave up for a couple years, just as I believe Councilman Blumenfield's office had hoped that I would.
