The CHC determined that the property conforms with the definition of a Monument pursuant to Section 22.171.7 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code. As a property that for generations has been open to everyone regardless of age, gender, and ethnicity for an affordable price without membership dues, Weddington Golf and Tennis is in a unique position between a public, municipal course and a private country club. Weddington Golf & Tennis complemented and supported surrounding suburban development in Studio City.
