My daughter is the youngest of 3, and to add we have been brave my daughters and I. Including myself means that we come together when we are able to as family during monitored visits and being proactive about these Life altering moments when a children's social worker decides which bell's and whistles matters in a moment and then again in her/ their/his reports and in my case it is regularly that embellishments are tacked onto facts and in doing so keeping my daughter in foster care remains the defaulted law. My daughter's current social worker is Gwethalyn Walker, her supervisor is Nayra Xu, the regional administrator is Lee Corbett and just by chance there is a worker on leave, currently that was the assigned children's social worker for my daughter. My daughter name is Vonyae and is 14. 

Comments for Public Posting: My name is Christina Boyar. I'm an attorney at Public Counsel and a member the Keep LA Housed Coalition and I live in CD5. These wildfires have devastated our communities and will continue to deeply impact tenants in LA City who are losing their homes, losing their income, being evicted, and facing price-gouging. We need rapid policy change to ensure housing stability and prevent spikes in rents and evictions as our City moves forward. I am urging the City Council to: Freeze rents citywide Enact an eviction moratorium Ban algorithmic rental price fixing and tenant screening Enforce anti-price gouging laws Set up immediate cash assistance/rent relief programs Enhance the rent registry Dedicate support for tenants seeking information and access to assistance programs These are common-sense emergency protections that should be implemented immediately. Additionally, the City should codify these measures into a permanent ordinance which automatically applies these protections when a state of emergency is declared.
