I have become aware that Verizon intends to violate the Colorado Boulevard Specific Plan by erecting a NEW 45 foot cell tower within 3 feet of a nearby residence and long established neighborhood. There also is NOT an existing cellular tower or facility at this location. I strongly oppose the lack of due process involved in this decision! There was never a Public Hearing on this matter. It did not happen. The ERNC Design Review Board is an advisory board only. A PUBLIC HEARING for planning such a structure has not gone before the planning commission. Verizon, by law, must present their project to the Area Planning Commission in a truly Public Hearing. This is not only a mistake, it is an egregious violation of the City of Los Angeles policy on Due Process. I am asking you to please act now and fix this mistake!
