We are writing to bring your attention to the proposed construction of a rehabilitation center adjacent to two Strike Park in La Crescent. We understand the center will help additives, however these facilities can bring increased traffic, safety issues, and potential exposure to substances that could endanger our children. We urge the county Council to intervene immediately to halt the construction process. Not only the proposed location is close to Two Strike Park, which are frequented by numerous children and families, but also it close to Rosemont Middle School, Monte Vista Elementary School(0.5 mile), Mountain Ave Elementary(1.5mile), and Valley View Elementary School(1.9mile). Given the potential risks and concerns associated with placing a rehabilitation center in such close proximity to recreational areas and educational institutions, we respectfully request that the county Council convene an urgent meeting to address this matter.
