**Comments for Public Posting:** It is 3:00 am on Saturday December 8th 2024 as I am writing this. I've called the LAPD, written complaints, but this is as much as I feel like I am allowed to do in order to speak up for myself, my neighbors, and everyone affected by this. Close to every night or every other night there are fireworks that are going off like bombs by the train tracks, underneath the first street bridge. This has been going on for so long and it seems like the city of Los Angeles has completely ignored what's going on. I live in the Pueblo Del Sol apartments in Boyle Heights. I've lived here all my life. I know my neighbors and my community. This is a working class neighborhood, with working class families. We do not need another stressor in our lives. At minimum, sleep should not be something we should have to sacrifice. When these fireworks are going off they're not done at any decent hours of the night, honestly they shouldn't be done at all as they are incredibly illegal. They're starting at 10 pm and going on as late as 3 or even past that. If the sun isn't up, they continue to light them. The day of the week does not matter to these people. I've experienced them happening on major holidays, after sporting events, but by far the worst is during the week when I'm trying to get sleep for work in the morning, as are all my neighbors. I also have elderly neighbors who are retired and really don't need to hear screeching, bombs going off at midnight. It seems like the people responsible are immune to the LAPD and the law. Something has to be done about this, and now. To continue to live like this is inhumane. Our sleep schedule should not revolve around these inconsiderate pyromaniacs who are wanting to party. I wonder, and welcome the council to argue this, if the reason nothing has been done about this is because there is no personal gain involved with the council or anyone that holds power in the city of Los Angeles. I hope that you see my reasoning, and take rational action to address and stop this.
