Dear Public Servants,

Im writing a second time to the City with much concern regarding the conditions of the Los Angeles County Jail. I realize that it is not a luxury hotel but I believe there are certain BASIC "standards" that should be met or the People start asking questions such as "Why the hell is mold growing on the wall?" or "Does OSHA know about these conditions?".

I have compiled a short list of concerns:

- commissary overpriced, inmates starving
- mail doesn't arrive
- no pens to write complaints
- food is cold
- rooms with water dripping - black mold
- third world conditions
- transparent discrimination against gay people...the other dorms are receiving supplies on time and not the gay dorm

I hope you can address these issues. If you cannot maintain a prison to BASIC LIVING STANDARDS and cant provide or afford the BASIC NECESSITIES for inmates, then what is going on? Maybe Los Angeles isn't qualified to maintain a jail system? It needs to be fixed. I will give you a few days then I will start calling numbers.
