Hi there! I noticed that your social media links only include Twitter (aka X), not Bluesky. I'm an LA citizen concerned about Twitter's anti-democratic owner and proprietary platform, and I urge you to consider moving to Bluesky instead. Bluesky is an open platform owned by a California B (public benefit) corporation, rather than a proprietary platform owned by a racist sociopath.

Switching will help the City and its departments engage with residents in a place where they don't have to worry about their messages being manipulated or blocked by a greedy billionaire. Several LA City officials and departments are already on Bluesky, including:

Getting started on Bluesky is easy:

- * Visit any Bluesky page (<https://bsky.app/>) and click the "Create account" button at bottom
- * Use your preferred social media management software to cross-post to Bluesky as well as Twitter (e.g. Hootsuite, Buffer, Vista Social)
- * Add a Bluesky link icon to each place on your site where you have a Twitter icon

The sooner we can get our public communications onto open platforms, the sooner we can get out of the grip of the wealthy. Please make this transition as soon as possible! Thanks!
