Dear Mayor Garcetti,

You have recently decided to close Los Angeles bars, nightclubs, restaurants (except takeout/delivery), entertainment venues and gyms until March 31 unless extended, in the interest of the public health. I am a resident and owner of a small 100+ year-old multifamily property. While your actions intend to protect the public, they will also effectively crush my small business, causing them to lay off employees, such as my renters who will now be out of work and not able to pay rent. Without their rent, my family will not be able to pay our mortgage nor our property taxes and your decision will also cause small business everywhere to layoff their staff, or cut back services drastically. Small mom and pop landlords such as myself are in fact small businesses.

I'm am writing to you today because Councilmember Mike Bonin, who I understand makes \$285,000 annually as a public servant to the City of Los Angeles, has introduced new legislation that would ban evictions during the Coronavirus. This will again shift the burden onto mom and pop landlords such as my family, who will face losing our properties because we cannot pay our mortgage nor property taxes. While Councilmember Bonin appears to have little understanding for private property, I would like to remind you that private property is not only the foundation for American prosperity, but the source of its underlying freedom. Councilmember Bonin has also introduced legislation to tax vacant apartment units due to the City's homeless crisis.

Your recent act to shutter small businesses and efficiently cripple the service industry which leads to massive layoffs, coupled with Mike Bonin's "Eviction Moratorium" will now place the burden on mom and pop landlords, who have put their savings into private property. The City of Los Angeles is now effectively working in lock step to violate our Fifth and Fourteenth Amendment rights. Specifically:

*The Constitution protects property rights through the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments' Due Process Clauses and, more directly, through the Fifth Amendment's Takings Clause: "nor shall private property be taken for public use without just compensation."*

*When government, through full condemnation, takes for public use not simply some or all of the owner's uses but the entire estate, including the title, compensation is clearly due.*

Also, please understand that it's near impossible to impose a ban on any mortgage, lender, or banking institution to stop collecting payments during these times, so your combined actions only cripple private property and small business owners, the very shareholders of the City that you were elected to represent. In order for you to counteract these clear and gross violations of our Fifth and Fourteenth Amendment rights, which is essentially a regulatory taking of private property rights, I suggest that you must do the following-

- 1) Impose a moratorium on real estate property taxes during the coronavirus to offset short sighted legislation put forth by Councilmember Bonin and others, which place the burden onto mom and pop landlords, homeowners, and small business owners.**
- 2) Impose a Los Angeles City Business tax moratorium for all small businesses during the coronavirus to keep small businesses afloat during such dangerous times.**
- 3) Impose a moratorium on all sales taxes in the City of Los Angeles during the Coronavirus. Most small businesses today work on such small profit margins, so a 9.5% LA City Sales tax is predatory during such dire times.**

If you are not able to do all of the three aforementioned acts, then this will only make the case that the City wishes to shift all of the economic pain onto the individual taxpayer and small business owner, avoiding any accountability or sacrifice itself. You see, our property taxes, business taxes, and sales taxes all go to also fund your salaries.

We have 15 LA City Councilmembers and if for example everyone is making \$285k annually, that brings us to an annual payroll of \$4.8 million dollars annually for 15 individuals who I believe have no understanding of economics, and appear to have no respect for private property. I would assume that each of the 15 councilmembers have a staff of at least 20 employees, plus you and your office of the mayor.

If you, our elected officials truly are the "business partners" of the City of Los Angeles, then like the sacrifices you and Mr. Bonin are asking of small business owners and landlords, it would appear time for you also to step up and sacrifice your revenues, just as you require us to do so.

The first three words of the US Constitution read, "We the people." We, the people, are shareholders of this great nation, and I am now beginning to believe that you have neglected to treat us as such. We pay property taxes in exchange for services, which have not been rendered.

Please let me know what the City can do on behalf of the shareholders of Los Angeles City.
