Dear Mayor Garcetti,

you will see in my attached picture that someone defecated in their pants outside my home last night and left for residents. I live in a highly residential area, one block from the beach and Bridge Housing. The City has suspended street cleaning during the Coronavirus outbreak to help residents with parking, but in areas with major homeless encampments, this is the worst thing that the City can possibly do at this point.

Feces is a hazardous material. Residents and families are walking on sidewalks with feces and tracking it into their homes. I live a block away from the Venice Dog Park, so dogs are walking on sidewalks and tracking it into their homes. Although Venice Beach is "closed," we still have many visitors coming daily and parking on residential streets such as mine, so they are walking on these sidewalks, spreading to other cities. I am now going to have to personally clean this "mess" out of concern for the public, so I am basically now doing your job.

Venice Beach homeless encampments have only multiplied over the last 3 weeks under the Coronavirus crisis. There is now a pop up "tiki bar" in the Rose Ave homeless encampment (picture attached)!! Further, Bridge Housing which houses 154 homeless individual is open for residents to enter and leave freely 24/7. I personally saw multiple people entering and leaving today and everyday over the past 3 weeks. Most Los Angelinos have taken your stay at home order seriously- forfeiting our livelihoods, giving up economic certainty, and quickly depleting our personal savings accounts... all in the interest in the public health. Why on earth should we continue to do this if these rules do not apply to 53,000 homeless in LA County?

Again, the 14th Amendment clearly states that there cannot be one set of rules for one group of people, and another set of rules for others. Your "stay at home" orders are in direct violation of the 14th amendment if you are unable to enforce them among the entire population. What is your plan here? What is it going to take to send out a hazmat team and start power washing sidewalks and cleaning up the streets in areas that are highly impacted by the homeless?

If I do not get coronavirus, I will end up with Typhus or Hepatitis.

Venice Beach requires hazmat cleanup services!! We pay property taxes in exchange for services, so if you fail to act accordingly, then you must exempt neighborhoods with large homeless populations from paying property taxes on April 10th. Afterall, "no taxation without representation," otherwise it is considered tyranny and a major factor during the American Revolution.

**2) Suspend all Sales Taxes for the next 6 months- Why on earth are we paying 9.5% in LA City sales taxes on essential goods why we try to stay alive - groceries, prescriptions, toilet paper, gas, bottled water, etc.**

**Perhaps you could lift sales taxes only on small businesses to incentivize Los Angelinos to shop local and keep our small businesses solvent during this crisis?**

You and your 15 well paid City Councilmembers, who all make over \$285,000 annually, plus their 20+ staff members, have created medieval like health conditions that will wipe out the homeless, our most vulnerable population. You have all personally benefited by creating a thriving Homeless Industrial Complex ("HIC") here in Los Angeles, where the homeless service providers and nonprofit developers make big money off the homeless headcount and then give elected officials campaign contributions... or donate directly to your nonprofits, which your own "Mayor's Fund for Los Angeles" has raked in millions. In short, taxpayer dollars have only padded the wallets of the (HIC) and never made it to the very people it was intended to help.

Mayor Garcetti, it is time for you to now step up and be a real leader. 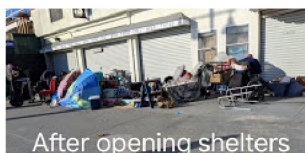

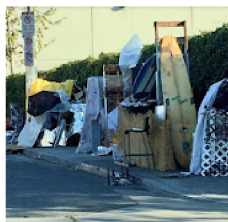

Dear Mayor Garcetti,  
you will see in my attached picture that someone defecated in their pants outside my home last night and left for residents. I live in a highly residential area, one block from the beach and Bridge Housing. The City has suspended street cleaning during the Coronavirus outbreak to help residents with parking, but in areas with major homeless encampments, this is the worst thing that the City can possibly do at this point.

Feces is a hazardous material. Residents and families are walking on sidewalks with feces and tracking it into their homes. I live a block away from the Venice Dog Park, so dogs are walking on sidewalks and tracking it into their homes. Although Venice Beach is "closed," we still have many visitors coming daily and parking on residential streets such as mine, so they are walking on these sidewalks, spreading to other cities. I am now going to have to personally clean this "mess" out of concern for the public, so I am basically now doing your job.

Venice Beach homeless encampments have only multiplied over the last 3 weeks under the Coronavirus crisis. There is now a pop up "tiki bar" in the Rose Ave homeless encampment (picture attached)! Further, Bridge Housing which houses 154 homeless individual is open for residents to enter and leave freely 24/7. I personally saw multiple people entering and leaving today and everyday over the past 3 weeks. Most Los Angelinos have taken your stay at home order seriously- forfeiting our livelihoods, giving up economic certainty, and quickly depleting our personal savings accounts... all in the interest in the public health. Why on earth should we continue to do this if these rules do not apply to 53,000 homeless in LA County?

Again, the 14th Amendment clearly states that there cannot be one set of rules for one group of people, and another set of rules for others. Your "stay at home" orders are in direct violation of the 14th amendment if you are unable to enforce them among the entire population. What is your plan here? What is it going to take to send out a hazmat team and start power washing sidewalks and cleaning up the streets in areas that are highly impacted by the homeless?

If I do not get coronavirus, I will end up with Typhus or Hepatitis.

Venice Beach requires hazmat cleanup services!! We pay property taxes in exchange for services, so if you fail to act accordingly, then you must exempt neighborhoods with large homeless populations from paying property taxes on April 10th. Afterall, "no taxation without representation," otherwise it is considered tyranny and a major factor during the American Revolution.

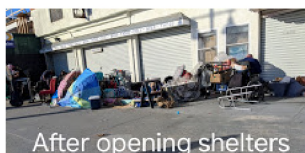

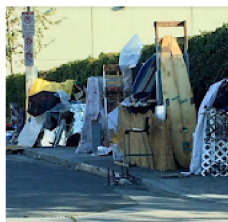
