Dear Mayor Garcetti &amp; Members of the City Council:

I received yet another astonishing and sad letter from Chief of Police Michel Moore on April 23, 2020 (copy upon request) making no mention of my deceased mother's personal property, \$287 and seventeen postage stamps (DR Number 191508319), still being withheld by the LAPD as of this writing. My mother expired in my presence on April 16, 2019, with the assistance and prompting of palliative care.

Previous memorandums from Chief of Police Michel Moore on this matter seemingly indicate that Chief Moore was not kept up to date and ill informed, having no knowledge of the events in real-time as they transpired chronologically.

I even received a written apology via e-mail, a matter of record (CF No: 19-001247) from the North Hollywood Station Captain during my mother's demise that he admittedly had been misinformed by his subordinates.

As I predicted and assumed at the onset of my complaint, the LAPD Internal Affairs Group is nothing more than a rubber stamp for the LAPD rigid behavior and policies in this matter. Even two (2) of you

senior staffers had no power or authority of your office to debate the matter with LAPD Strategic Command overseeing the North Hollywood Station's behavior, your two (2) senior staffers simply reiterating the rigid behavior and policies of LAPD relative to my deceased mother's personal property still being withheld (\$287 and seventeen postage stamps).

This brings to mind the enormous cash and property withheld by LAPD, not claimed or never claimed, that could be put to use for your caring and compassionate "Mayor's Fund" in this time of growing crisis with COVID-19.

My only alternative is to follow the guidance, suggestion and prompting from the California State Attorney General, a memorandum forwarded to the Attorney General from Governor Gavin Newsom, wherein I am to notify the Attorney General once ALL local resources and avenues have been exhausted.

(N.B.: I have already contacted your City Attorney and his staff, Honorable members of the City Council, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors, all members of the Los Angeles Police Commission, the District Attorney's office as well as the entire LAPD Strategic Command.)

You see, Honorable Garcetti, your care, overwhelming compassion and soulful sensitivity for the City of Los Angeles—and your tears when reporting the fallen Angels—leads me to one final proposal for CLOSURE:

#### OPTION ONE of TWO (NOT Preferred)

I request that you direct the LAPD, with the full authority and jurisdiction of your office, to release my mother's \$287 and the value for seventeen postage stamps (DR Number 191508319) and I vow to donate ALL of these funds with 50% to the "Ventura Area Agency On Aging (VCAAA)" and the remaining 50% to "Food Share Ventura County" whose assistance my spouse and I have received as two seniors living alone with preexisting medical conditions and with no family or children, living in fear for our lives due to COVID-19.

#### OPTION TWO of TWO (Preferred)

I request that you direct the LAPD, with the full authority and jurisdiction of your office, to release my mother's \$287 and the value for seventeen postage stamps (DR Number 191508319) to the City of Los Angeles so that your designated staffer may donate ALL of these funds with 50% to the "Ventura Area Agency On Aging (VCAAA)" and the remaining 50% to "Food Share Ventura County."

(I have already pledged to donate 10% of my federal stimulus funds, when received, equally divided between the two above mentioned agencies due to the inspiration and forward-looking actions of Governor Newsom.)

If either of these two option are agreeable to you and plausible, I will:

1. Let go and DISMISS the issue of an LAPD detective who looked me in the eye and personally told me that all I needed to retrieve my deceased mother's property was a valid County of Los Angeles Death Certificate, which was later insufficient (my name appearing as "Informant" and Son) for which Chief of Police Michel Moore claims is "Unfounded" in his letter of April 23, 2020.
2. Let go and DISMISS that the supervisor of this LAPD detective told me over the phone that I would be a "bad son" (exact words, for which

Chief of Police Michel Moore claims is "Unfounded" in his letter of April 23, 2020) by not allowing the "former" caregiver ("former" according to the County Board of Supervisors, Hon. Sheila Kuehl) to continue to withhold additional checks, without any written or legal documentation, not turned over to the North Hollywood Police Department, being told that this "former" caregiver had a binding oral agreement, according to LAPD memos, yet my oral agreement with my dying mother was not even considered.

(To the best of my knowledge and belief, the North Hollywood Police Station "allowed" the FORMER caregiver to retain my deceased mother's property, yet I was denied my deceased mother's property even with a valid Death Certificate as I was formerly misinformed IN PERSON would be sufficient.)

3. Let go and DISMISS that an alleged forged Bank of America check, # 7902, February 3, 2019, copied to the North Hollywood Police Station, was never investigated to the best of my knowledge and belief for which Chief of Police Michel Moore claims is "Unfounded" in his letter of April 23, 2020.

Finally, Honorable Mayor Garcetti, I offer to you the following for some personal, deeper soul reflection: If this had happened to Vince Scully, who you so honorably lauded recently, or the kind gentlemen who passed away and who gave fame and municipal prestige to the Los Angeles River, what action would you have taken?

Your answer to this—not to me—will reveal the depth and horizon of your deepening human soul!
