We are deeply concerned about the idea to put a homeless encampment in the parking lot at **749 S LOS ANGELES ST**

This parking lot is not large enough to house the hygiene trucks as well as the RV Trailers or Pallets They intend to install. So, the hygiene trunks will need to be curbside.

This parking lot is surrounded by more than 2,000 homeowners and residents. Some of which are in the over 60 age group ,some of which have health issues that will put them at risk. And with the rate that the COVID virus is currently erupting throughout the homeless community. This is very concerning, that after nearly 2 months of staying at home and with some lockdowns starting to be released, we as a community are going to put at a new risk.

There are several restaurants directly adjacent to this lot. Residential multi-story properties are alongside , behind and opposite the lot. With more than 15 retail clothing stores surrounding this proposed lot. Some of which have been in business for many decades. These businesses will be severely compromised with their only form of customer parking, in an area where there is already lack of parking, being taken away from them.

Two large property buildings are currently being restored and converted into office and retail spaces with three new food halls under current construction directly next to and opposite the site.

All of which had the potential to bring much needed revenue and taxes into the downtown area of Los Angeles.

Many stores that are already suffering due to the COVID closures in the Fashion industry ,will be severely impaired by having a homeless camp place directly behind ,adjacent or opposite their businesses.
