Good morning, it is Friday morning and in response to my screen caps to the web master or my emails generated last night I see that now minutes have been posted

However, last night that was not possible for a stakeholder to see them.

There were no minutes as stated available for either the August 7 or the August 14 meetings via web or in person draft missing.

The September 11 meeting in person had the four page agenda. Had we wanted the attachments we had to download the web was in active in and out at the school last night you could check with the transcriber. The minutes were not posted at that time on the web for any of the months stated and nothing but the fourth page agenda and not very many copies.

A stakeholder should be able to see anything given to the board we were not able to in any fashion. There were no copies.

So, when you see it today and when you heard my protest yesterday, and not one person (president Ronquillo, Mr. Gibson, ? They could have me, oh we went ahead and approved fraudulent minutes from April through June 2025 at the August meeting" and could've brought the web up-to-date by giving instructions to the webmaster. Instead, they let me continue when my position was clearly stated to everyone.

April through June is still not valid. I am moving forward with both matters (retroactive training and the April 12 egg hunt post funding approval.) A board member last night stated that it was correct that bias training had not been completed. No matter which category of training was not completed. They only all became current as of July 3 nothing prior for the members I had mentioned in the June minutes (that is on record that was approved that should be reviewed and will be presented as necessary.)

I don't see why I have to be at odds with my neighborhood council who try deliberately to keep us in the dark when they have committed violations of the law.

As always, the Granada Hills South neighborhood Council feels that after the fact is retroactive. Like training, it is not.

They have changed it this morning in response to my complaint, but it does not matter, This was not the case last night.

I have downloaded every item and I have copies of all the minutes during this time and fabricated agendas. I have screen capped items. This is how I have learned to operate and it is ridiculous.

Good Morning Board & Mr. Davandry: I'm copying Aaron Davandry (email only) and the GHSNC Board directly so Aaron Davandry has the first opportunity to respond to my inquiry. I will also send a hard copy via the U.S. Mail to the Board at [11024 Balboa Blvd., #767, Granada Hills, CA 91344](#) to ensure this request is part of the official public record.

I'm writing to clarify who is responsible for managing the GHSNC website. According to Item VIII c: Motion to approve \$1,800.00 per year to use Aaron Davandry to use Aaron Devandry as the Granada Hills South Council Webmaster Of the August 7, 2025 minutes*, Aaron Davandry is compensated \$1,800 per year for website services—yet some updates come from "webmaster@empowerla.lacity.org," which suggests EmpowerLA involvement.

I've reached out to Aaron Devandry previously through the GHSNC site but haven't received a response, while EmpowerLA staff have replied to similar inquiries. Could you please confirm:

- Which individual or entity holds administrative access and publishing authority for ghsnc.org?
- Whether Aaron Davandry is the sole contractor for content updates and maintenance. Has he been vetted as a Vendor, is there a contract or Agreement? It is important to VET not REGRET as I've heard from Ms. Waters.
- If EmpowerLA staff are involved, under what agreement or authority they operate.
- Who ensures the website complies with Brown Act posting requirements and accurately reflects board actions.

Please ensure this request is docketed with the City Clerk's Public Records Division to maintain a formal public record.

I appreciate your assistance in clarifying this matter.
