To Whom It May Concern,

My name is Enri and I am writing to submit yet another demand for cure and correct against the East Hollywood Neighborhood Council (abbreviated and hereto referred Specifically, EHNC did not post the agenda for their public Board Meeting scheduled on Monday September 15, 2025 at 7pm.

I am normally lenient with reporting Neighborhood Councils if they do not post the agenda as required by law prior to the meeting, as sometimes it can be a clerical error and the public duly noted via their other online outlets of communication, such as their social media accounts. However, this is not the first/second/third time EHNC has their regularly scheduled Board Meeting was never posted. The attached screenshots are taken at two different intervals of time as proof of this behavior. The first was on Monday September 15, 2025 at 10:39pm.

Even worse, this egregious pattern of behavior continues by the EHNC mere days after I reported them for another such violation.

I want to be clear here - this is a pattern of behavior with one particular Neighborhood Council, of which Jeff Zarrinam serves as a board member of. Jeff has been caught at public meetings (such as the Business Improvement District Committee and Business Committee) and never posting the agendas. This continued pattern of behavior is deemed to be open spaces whereby we the public can have our grievances heard and fellow community members be made aware of issues going on right in their very own neighborhoods.

Again, I remind the City of LA that this issue of cutting the public out of public meetings through tactics like not posting the agendas has already been well adjudicated - see Central District Court of California. He sued and won over \$1 million for the same behaviors being exhibited here by EHNC.

Repeated and ongoing trainings for board and committee members on the Brown Act is a must. This very issue of suppressing the public's right to speak, especially at off public meetings, is clearly neglecting their responsibilities. I am suing the City of Los Angeles for. The City Attorney's office along with the District Attorney's office are supposed to take such matters seriously and provide prompt and effective remedies.

I have pleaded with the city through official administrative channels to address and correct this very kind of behavior, which sadly is far more egregious by City Council and the municipal body.

As always, two good role models abiding by the Brown Act include Downtown LA Neighborhood Council and Central Hollywood Neighborhood Council.

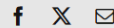
