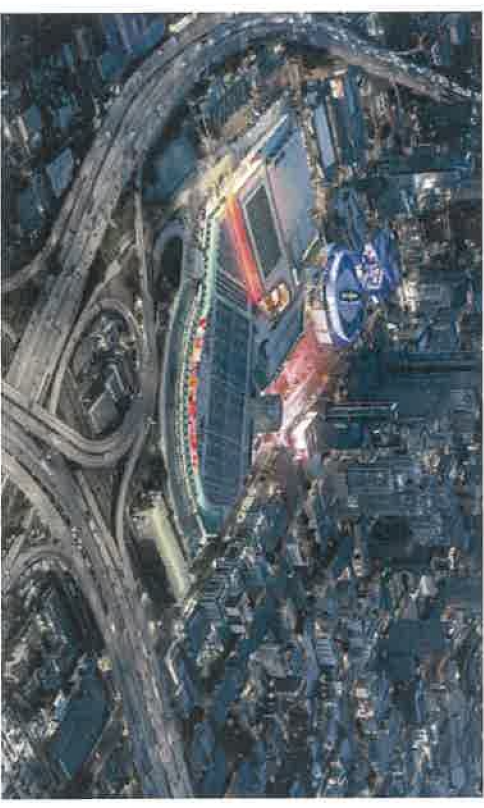

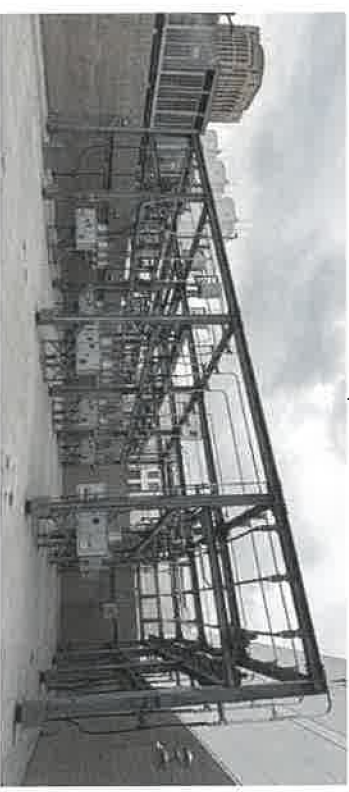

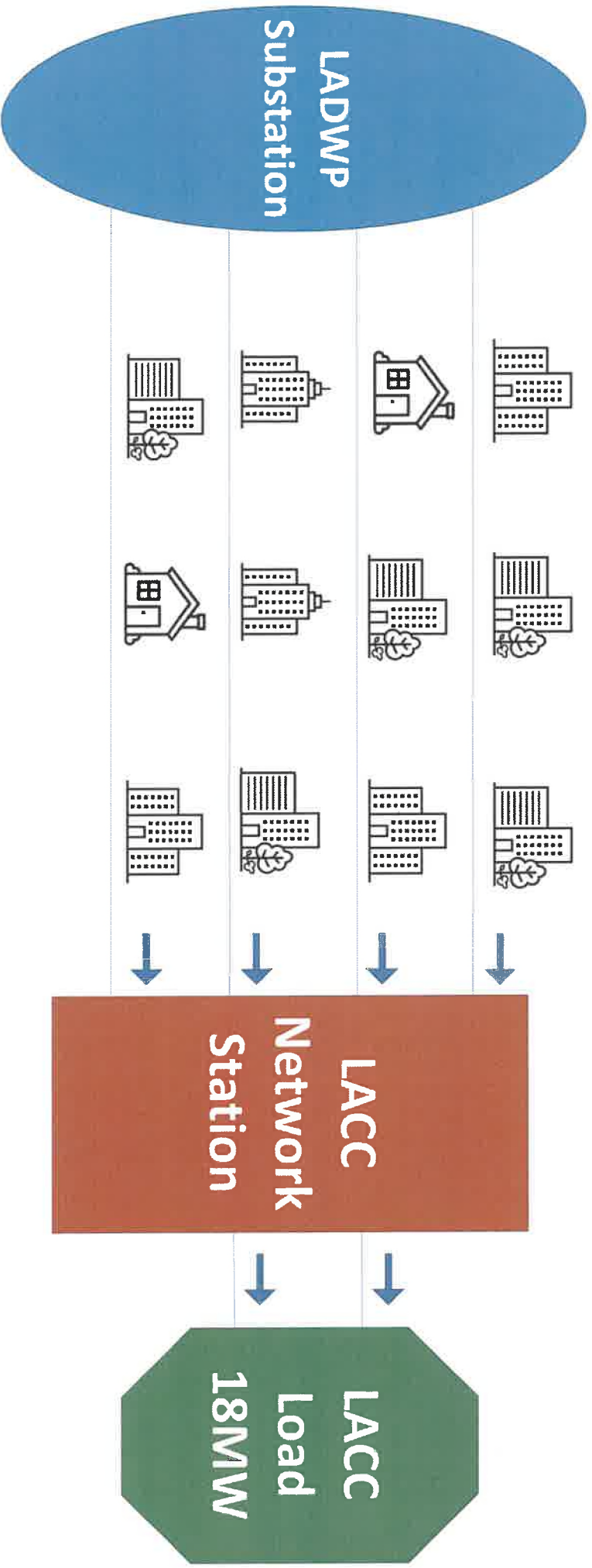

N-1 Redundancy and Resiliency

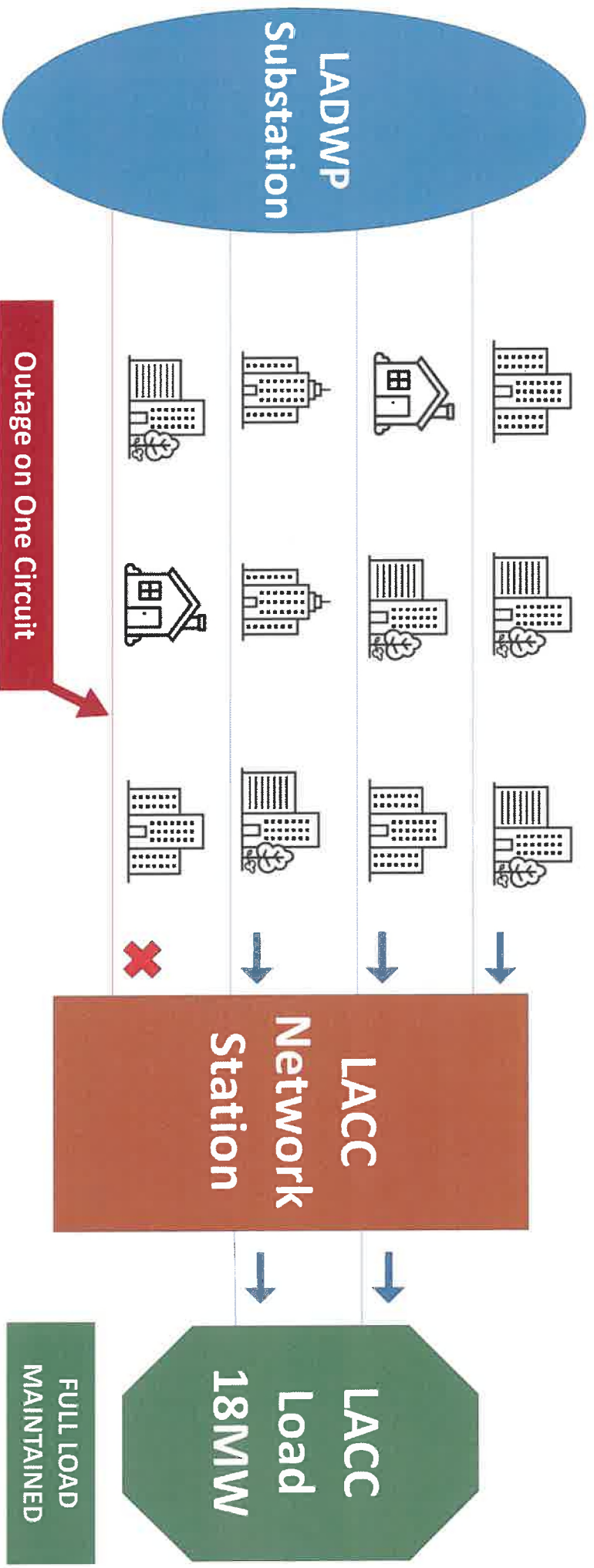
NETWORK STATION WITH N-1 REDUNDANCY AND RESILIENCY
