Good day City Clerk Office:

Anna Martinez, in your City Clerk's office shared with me via email that the City Clerk has a New Public Comment Portal to send requests previously ignored at City Hall, and ignored beyond City Hall within LA County.

Thus via this new portal, I now ask that the City Clerk’s office add to an upcoming City Council Agenda why if student truancies are a precursor to homelessness why are they ignored by Schools in at least LA County and Local Government (City and County offices) until after they first commit crimes or become homeless?

My proposal below assumes that the County should have implemented the 2014 Blue Ribbon Commission Report that ordered that the County was to implement a “single coordinated automated tracking system” as to “troubled youth” and then also be tracking their parents and or guardians who might be neglecting them; in this manner Schools could begin to inform Local Government, to then have those offices use their computers to triage matches in their systems, giving County Social Workers an “early warning” signal, to then to go make sure truancies were not masking Child abuse at a School or in a Home, currently ignored.

Why not implemented, leaving “we the people” to observe that current Local Government Elected and Staff’s continue to be able to claim “not my job, if not given notice via the 2014 Blue Ribbon Commission Report; and in this manner to hopefully save taxpayer funded dollars at waste, and KIDS to now become Homeless, if without a “free” K-12 public education?

Why since 2012, after “we the people” voter passed Proposition 30 that promised Accountability of the California Education Code, have LA County Schools not used 21st Century tools of automation (computers) and placed Local Government (City and County offices) on notice electronically, leaving these KIDS, about 550,000 LA County students per year ignored, who make-up about 1/3 of those counted as enrolled students, who are not in schools during school hours, in excess of three times during the year unexcused?

Is it time to have Schools become into compliance with at least ED Code Sections 48321 and 49061?

Asked differently, why for example at LAUSD, as reported to the State, as reprinted below last year, are ignored KIDS representing an 11.90% Chronic Absenteeism Rate, skewing upward the County Rate of 11.0%; begging the question when will LAUSD deal with Absenteeism, if ignored Student Truancies are a precursor to Homelessness, knowing that the County Homeless Rate increased last year by 12%? How many were ignored truants?

Thank you now in advance to now correct perceived failures at LA County Schools and beyond Statewide, including LA City and County offices, as to failed truancy reporting, now making sure LA County Schools and beyond Statewide begin to do their jobs; and therefore having Local Government offices now be now placed on notice electronically at ZERO added cost, and therefore City and County Elected and Staffs can no longer claim "not my job", when truants are not in school during school hours, potentially in the streets robbing houses in your neighborhoods – get the picture?
