Hope you're having a good day. My name is Amita, and I'm a resident at [redacted] with a paid permit to park on the street.

As I work until late night; I often don't return home until late night & rarely find a parking spot despite having paid to simply park my car. When I do, there's often signs to move my car for street sweeping the next morning. I have been waking up early to move my car and for consecutive weeks now, I've seen absolutely no street sweeping occur.

If I am getting home late, waking up early despite paying tax dollars & money to park, it makes me extremely upset to see the city not doing their one job over which my life has become miserable but I'm sure the city parking officials would be quick to ticket me whether or not street sweeping happens.

On top of this I'm tired of the city distributing permits if there is not enough space. As a single woman who comes home late at night, I've seen shady characters in my area all too often as of recent and I'm afraid to come home because I know that I might not get to park anywhere close to my home despite paying to do so & will have to walk alone (often half a mile) in the dark from a zone that has nothing to do with my permit.

As street sweeping is a city service that is affecting my health, I would hope you can provide appropriate reasoning and documentation as to why it no longer happens. If it isn't going to happen, I ask that you remove the parking restrictions associate with it. Please also advise actual solutions on parking safety.
