Dear Councilmember Bonin,

I am writing because I am concerned over the use of your social media accounts, because your multiple Facebook accounts violate the first amendment rights of its constituents and the public.

You currently have three Facebook accounts - 1) Mike Bonin (personal) account, 2) Mike Bonin Campaign Page, and 3) Councilmember Mike Bonin (official) account.

These pages block users, they restrict comments, deny the ability to post pictures as comments, hide & delete comments that are negative. I have noticed multiple times that comments made by myself and other constituents suddenly go missing.

Please take a look at Mayor Eric Garcetti's Facebook page, which fully conforms to free speech laws. The Mayor allows all comments posted, he does not disable the ability to post pictures in the comments. The Mayor does not manipulate comments. Please do as the Mayor has done and use his accounts as a model to correct yours.

- Your personal facebook page must allow anyone to follow and comment, you may not block anyone.
- Your Official City Council page must allow anyone to post any type of response, including pictures which are currently not allowed.
- You must stop muting, hiding, and deleting comments made by the public to your posts.

You use these accounts to in an official manner to communicate with the public, which constitutes that this account is a public forum. Therefore, blocking access, blocking pictures and postings by the community, and hiding, deleting, and muting public comments violate our First Amendment rights.

Please make the following changes immediately to conform with the Law. For your convenience, I have included a legal precedent below. Thank you,

A legal precedent exists. Please refer to [Knight First Amendment Institute v. Trump](#).

In July 2017, a lawsuit was brought by the Knight First Amendment Institute at Columbia University in United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, to address Twitter users, whose accounts had been blocked from President Donald Trump's personal Twitter account, alleging that the @realDonaldTrump account constitutes a public forum. The lawsuit argues that blocking access to @realDonaldTrump account is a violation of constitutional rights and a violation of the plaintiff's First Amendment rights. Issues arise as to how the Constitution applies to freedom of speech in digital computer technologies that facilitate the creation and sharing of information, ideas, career interests and other forms of expression via virtual communities and networks.

In May 2018, U.S. district judge Naomi Reice Buchwald of the Southern District of New York ruled that the plaintiffs "were indisputably blocked as a result of viewpoint discrimination." She also ruled that elements of @realDonaldTrump constitute a public forum. Viewpoint discrimination in those elements that are public forums is a violation of the First Amendment.

The Second Circuit upheld Buchwald's ruling, stating that because Trump has conducted official government business over Twitter, he cannot block Americans from the account.
