An old lie keeps returning to continue fulfilling it's role as a scapegoat cause of Veteran homelessness in Los Angeles; as well as to support false statements such as: "it's illegal to house homeless Veterans at the WLA VA since the VA took over the NHDVS Program", "we need this (disguised reform) bill to finally let the WLA VA build housing for homeless Veterans" and "only private developers that must get 99-year leases can build housing for homeless Veterans at WLA VA".

Well, a tour through the definitive truth on the matter will be out before Lieu and Feinstein try to pass yet another destructive and deadly WLA VA Soldiers Home land use reform bill "in honor of homeless vets". Until then, I thought you might be interested in some background on the 1971 Sylmar Earthquake.

The 1971 Sylmar Earthquake destroyed the Sepulveda VA. As evidence in so many authoritative reports, including an extensive one by the U.S. Department of Commerce - there was no significant damage to the WLA VA Soldiers Home.

Shortly after the quake, an uncanny group called the HUD-Space-Science sub-committee established the Southern California Regional Medical District program, which was mostly staffed / controlled by the University of California. That rogue group contrarily "found" that every building you can find a disabled Veteran in (that isn't a research guinea pig), including the Wadsworth Hospital; was either damaged or caused to be seismically unsafe by the Sylmar quake... A grave lie by which the District's head spin-doctor, John J. Cox, promptly evicted 1,200 - 2,800 disabled Veterans from the WLA VA Soldiers Home... The Big Bang of Veteran Homelessness in what remains our Nation's Capital of Veteran Homelessness.

Meanwhile, the University of California was finishing up their plans to demolish the Wadsworth Hospital and replace it with a research-focused hospital with 990,000 square feet of UCLA Medical School residency program operations. Once the disabled Veterans were evicted, the University of California declared, "hey, here's a great idea, why don't we just take these plans for a purported UC San Diego hospital and use them to build a new Veterans hospital at the WLA VA!"

In order to help finance the University of California hospital takeover, tens of millions of dollars appropriated toward rebuilding the Sepulveda VA hospital, were re-directed to the WLA VA research hospital.

Meanwhile, UCLA quietly moved into most of the other buildings disabled Veterans were evicted from, evidently to perform once-secret, deadly research upon disabled Veterans.

When the hospital was completed, UCLA began performing cardiac related research studies from it that not only led to at minimum of hundreds of deaths, but also got them suspended from all WLA VA Research; but just for a year or so, thanks to UC Lobbyist cum VA Official Kenneth Kizer's efforts to "fix the problems".

Ever since the 1971 Sylmar Quake, members of Congress like Diane Feinstein, who's husband is a UC Regent, have appropriated hundreds of millions of dollars to make the "necessary seismic improvements" to WLA VA Buildings (UCLA operates in) that can't house homeless Veterans again until complete. NONE of such work was completed. In fact, the private developers conning taxpayers and Veterans into snagging WLA VA Buildings 205, 207 & 208 have been fully exempted from performing such "seismic upgrades".

So how many of you know UCLA plans on tearing down the WLA VA Hospital again? If not many, I'm not surprised... They never tell you about illegal and fraudulent developments until shortly after construction begins, like that additional baseball field UCLA appears to have just started, right next to the existing one that Dianne Feinstein gave her husband as a Public Law Statute in the West Los Angeles Leasing Act of 2016 we were all told was to house homeless Veterans.

I hope this helps you understand why all of Ms. Feinstein and Mr. Lieu's WLA VA land use reform bills disguised as something helping homeless Veterans are passed in empty chambers of Congress by voice votes upon suspending the

rules... Like the "WLA VA Campus Improvement Act" Lieu will try to illegally push through Congress amid not a single co-sponsor.
