I strongly believe that all of Wendy Greuel's past and present career experiences would make her a very experienced and highly skilled Interim Mayor of Los Angeles if she does get selected to serve as the Interim Mayor of Los Angeles once the Los Angeles City Council President, which is currently Nury Martinez, officially assumes the role of Acting Mayor of Los Angeles.
