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MOTION

On Tuesday, June 27, 2006, BET Television will be staging the "BET Awards" at the Shrine Auditorium. The show will be taped in front of a live audience and then be broadcast to millions of viewers across the country. The BET 25th Anniversary Event will directly benefit the City by continuing to showcase Los Angeles as the entertainment capital of the world.

The City has received a request to temporarily close certain streets, provide traffic control and declare the function a Special Event. Approval of this request will mean that an estimated \$15,000 in fees and salary costs will be absorbed by the city. [Event Coordinator - Mary Pat Cantrell phone/818-769-9800; fax/818-255-9584].

I THEREFORE MOVE that the "BET Awardst" be declared a Special Event, and that all City departments be requested to waive all fees, costs, and requirements, except insurance.

I FURTHER MOVE that pursuant to ordinance No. 150,567 relating to temporary street closures, the following streets and sidewalks be closed to accommodate the event, subject to supervision of the Director of the Bureau of Street Service:

- Royal Street (Plaza) between Jefferson Boulevard and 32nd Street from 12:00 a.m. on Monday, June 26, 2006 thru 12:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 28, 2006.
- 32nd Street between Royal Street and Figueroa Street from 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 27, 2006 thru 2:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 28, 2006. Local and emergency access must be maintained at all times as well as pick-up and drop-off at 32nd Street/USC MAST Elementary School.
- Westbound Jefferson Boulevard between Figueroa Street and Hoover Street from 12:00 p.m. thru 11:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 27, 2006. Local and emergency access must be maintained at all times.
- Shrine Place between 30th Street and 32nd Street from 12:00 p.m to 11:00 p.m.. on Tuesday, June 27, 2006. Local and emergency access must be maintained at all times.
- North sidewalk of Jefferson Boulevard between Figueroa Street and Hoover Street from 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 27, 2006 thru 1:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 28, 2006.
- South sidewalk of 32nd Street between Royal Street and Figueroa Street from 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 27, 2006 thru 2:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 28, 2006.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation be directed to post "Temporary No Parking" signs on all affected streets, and provide traffic control personnel, as required.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation post "Temporary No Parking" signs on Figueroa Street between 32nd Street and Jefferson Boulevard from 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 27, 2006 thru 12:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 28, 2006 to facilitate limousine arrivals and departures.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Street Services be directed to furnish the necessary traffic control devices. These devises will be provided with the understanding that the sponsoring organization will pick up and return them to the Bureau.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation and the Los Angeles Police Department be authorized to close any additional streets or sidewalks, at their, discretion, that are necessary to facilitate public safety and traffic flow during this event.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation, the Los Angeles Police Department and the Los Angeles Fire Department be requested to provide assistance as needed in working with the organizer to develop and implement a security plan for the event.

I FURTHER MOVE that should unforeseen circumstances changes the actual date of the Special Event the aforementioned departmental instructions continue to apply.
