This is to advise you that on 11/03/2006 the California Transportation Commission adopted a resolution relinquishing to the City of Los Angeles a portion of State Highway Route 170 (Highland Avenue), from Santa Monica Boulevard to 0.1 mile north of Pilgrimage Bridge designated 07-LA-170-PM 9.1/10.7.

This resolution was recorded on 01/19/2006 as Document No. 06-0138363 in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County. Payment of funds was delivered to city on 01/19/2006 and the effective date of said relinquishment is 01/19/2006.

Final documents will be mailed to you as soon as they are processed. The County Recorder's office has need of 35 working days to process documents.

CITY OF LOS ANGELES, ROAD 07-LA-170-PM 9.1/10.7

WHEREAS, by cooperative agreement dated
September 20, 2005, between the City of Los Angeles and the State
of California, the City agreed to accept title to a portion of
State Highway Route 170 lying within the City limits, upon
relinquishment thereof to said City by the State of California;
and

WHEREAS, by said cooperative agreement the City of Los
Angeles is willing to accept a lump sum payment as the State's
total responsibility to place said portion of Route 170 in a
state of good repair; and

WHEREAS, this Commission does hereby approve the terms
and conditions of said cooperative agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Commission has the authority by
resolution to relinquish pursuant to Legislative enactment; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 470 of the Streets and Highways Code, as amended by Chapter 650 Statutes of 2004, this Commission has found and determined, and does hereby find and determine, that it is desirable and in the public interest that said highway be relinquished to the City of Los Angeles for use as a city street;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS VOTED by the California Transportation Commission that it relinquish and it does hereby relinquish, to the City of Los Angeles, effective upon the recordation of a certified copy hereof with the Recorder of Los Angeles County, all of the State of California's right, title and interest in and to said State highway, described as follows:


All those portions of State highway deleted from the State highway system by legislative enactment, namely, Assembly Bill No. 3047, signed by the Governor on September 21, 2004, and shown as SEGMENTS 1 and 2, as depicted on that certain map filed October 4, 2005, in State Highway Map Book No. 20 at page 71, Records of Los Angeles County.
