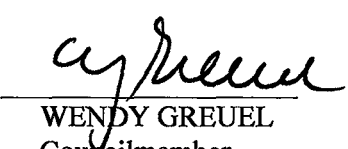
1. That the deaths of Michael Tardio and Christopher Monson were caused by the willful misconduct of one or more persons.

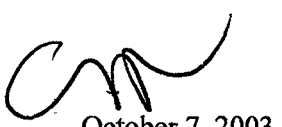
