



Council District 7 in conjunction with The San Fernando Valley Veterans Day Parade Committee, will sponsor the "3rd Annual San Fernando Valley Veterans Day Parade, Carnival, Festival and Community Fair" on November 11, 2006. An estimated 2,000 people will attend this event featuring various branches of the armed forces, military organizations, ROTC groups, floats, special guests, marching bands and military displays.

Council District Seven has received a request that the City provides certain services and declares the function a Special Event. Approval of this request will mean that an estimated \$6,682 in fees and salary costs will be absorbed by the city. (Event Coordinator: Dennis O'Sullivan (818-481-0607).

I THEREFORE MOVE that the 3rd Annual San Fernando Valley Veterans Day Parade and Community Fair sponsored by Council District 7 and The San Fernando Valley Veterans Day Parade Committee be declared a Special Event and that City departments be required to waive all fees, costs, and requirements, except for insurance.

I FURTHER MOVE that pursuant to Ordinance No. 150,567 relating to temporary street closures, those streets comprising the Route of the Parade, as set forth in the Special Event Permit Application, be closed on November 11th, 2006 from 6:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. along Laurel Canyon Blvd from Rinaldi Street to Filmore Street, subject to the supervision of the Director of the Bureau of Street Services.

I FURTHER MOVE that pursuant to Ordinance No. 150,567 relating to temporary street closures, those streets comprising the Formation Area for the parade, as set forth in the Special Event Permit Application, be closed on November 11th, 2006 from 6:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. along San Fernando Mission Blvd from Sharp Avenue to Alcala Avenue, along Kalisher Street from Laurel Canyon Blvd to Alcala Avenue and along Rincon Avenue from Kalisher Street to Harding Street, subject to the supervision of the Director of the Bureau of Street Services.

I FURTHER MOVE that pursuant to Ordinance No. 150,567 relating to temporary street closures, those streets comprising the VIP Area for the parade, as set forth in the Special Event Permit Application, be closed on November 11th, 2006 from 6:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. along Laurel Canyon Blvd from San Fernando Mission Blvd to Chatsworth Drive, along Brand Blvd from Amboy Avenue to the 5 Freeway and along Chatsworth Drive from Rincon Avenue to the 5 Freeway, subject to the supervision of the Director of the Bureau of Street Services.


