Letter:

Greetings,

I am writing to respectfully ask you to save the southern sidewalk on the Glendale Hyperion Bridge. With the current plan for the redesign of the bridge, pedestrians can't safely or legally cross to the other side of the street to use the proposed single sidewalk without a lengthy detour. The city shouldn't be taking away one of our sidewalks. It should be making both sidewalks safer and more accessible, so that people of all ages and abilities can safely take active transportation across the Glendale Hyperion bridge.

Our city has been working to create great streets and safe streets. We also need great bridges and safe bridges - ones that connect neighborhoods, rather than divide them. We need bridges that provide safe and accessible active transportation options for all, that are in line with our city's adopted General Plan and the proposed Mobility Element. We need to improve walkability, rather than thwart it, and we need this not only in the name of access and equity, but also for the improved mobility, health and the economic prosperity of our communities and city. In the words of our mayor Eric Garcetti in a letter regarding the design of this bridge, it should be "as multi-modal as possible."

This Glendale Hyperion Bridge was jointly paid for by Los Angeles County, the city of Glendale, and the city of Los Angeles to provide one of the few points of connection over the LA river, and now the 5 freeway. Today this bridge links three vibrant and interconnected communities of Atwater, Los Feliz and Silver Lake, with two pedestrian areas on either side of the bridge, and destinations and services on both the north and south sides of the bridge, that include everything from grocery

stores to restaurants, cafes, gyms, gift stores, art studios, dance classes, yoga studios, real estate offices, child play areas, churches, pet services, bars, dry cleaning, salons, health and wellness facilities, liquor stores, wine stores, sound mixing studios, film and media production offices, and architecture firms to name a few. This bridge is also crossed daily during the school year by a substantial number of Marshall High School students who use it to go and from school on foot and by bicycle.

We are glad that the city plans to retrofit the Glendale Hyperion Bridge to make it safer from earthquake damage. However, we feel strongly that any redesign of this bridge should also include ADA compliant sidewalks the length of both sides of the bridge, signalized crosswalks that would allow pedestrians to safely access these sidewalks on the bridge, and buffered bike lanes the length of both sides of the bridge so that active transportation options are available to individuals regardless of age and ability, not just the daring few.

We understand that given the historic designation and the current footprint of the bridge that the space on the bridge is limited. We support Option 3 which reduces one lane of eastbound vehicular traffic to increase room for active transportation options. While we understand mobility by private auto is important for many in the community, this bridge represents a real and perhaps unparalleled opportunity to provide safe and accessible active transportation with no predicted slow down of traffic.

Pedestrians, particularly the Marshall high school students who are brave enough to regularly cross the bridge on foot as it is now, need the protection provided by wide accessible sidewalks and signalized crosswalks allowing them access to these sidewalks. The collision history shows an elevated rate of speed-related crashes at the base of the bridge in Atwater Village where drivers failed to slow down upon entering the business district. There is no compelling reason to maintain higher capacity for vehicles on this bridge, and consequently higher speeds of vehicles, when doing so fails to relieve traffic congestion and further eliminates active transportation options.

Please look at this complex engineering problem with an open mind and through the eyes of the community members who regularly use or would like to use this bridge for active transportation. People walk and bicycle across this bridge now, even as it is unsafe. More people will walk and bicycle across the bridge if it were safer. We are writing to implore you to connect these intertwined communities, which share so many services, through robust and comprehensive active transportation options.
