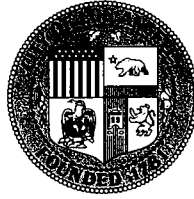

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the establishment of a voluntary City-wide sidewalk repair program modeled after Council District 2's (CD 2) "50/50 Sidewalk Repair Pilot Program" in Fiscal Year (FY) 2005-06.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Greuel - Smith - Hahn):

NOTE and FILE the March 24, 2006 Bureau of Street Services (BOSS) report relative to the establishment of a voluntary City-wide sidewalk repair program modeled after CD 2's "50/50 Sidewalk Repair Pilot Program" in FY 2005-06, inasmuch as this report is for information only and no Council action is required.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Not applicable

SUMMARY

On February 2, 2005 Council introduced a Motion (Greuel - Smith - Hahn) relative to directing the BOSS to work with the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and report on the feasibility of using a portion of the City's sidewalk repair funds to establish a voluntary City-wide sidewalk repair program modeled after CD 2's the "50/50 Sidewalk Repair Pilot Program" in Fiscal Year (FY) 2005-06. According to the Motion, in September 2004, CD 2 launched a 90-day "50/50 Sidewalk Repair Pilot Program" to increase the amount of sidewalks repaired in CD 2 utilizing 50% of their allocated General Fund repair monies matched with residents' contributions. As a result of this program, 20% more sidewalks were repaired in CD 2 this year than in previous years. To ensure that residents of all income levels were able to have their sidewalks repaired, CD 2 specifically set aside funds for sidewalk repairs in low-income neighborhoods.


At its regular meeting held on April 5, 2006, your Committee considered a March 24, 2006 BOSS report in response to the above Motion. According to the BOSS, the 50/50 Sidewalk Repair Program was expanded City-wide beginning in July 2005. The BOSS focused on discussing the program with interested homeowners, providing estimates and executing agreements over the subsequent months. Due to the overwhelming demand and to allow the BOSS to initiate all work by a committed June 30, 2006 date, requests received after January 2006 are being deferred until next year, assuming the Program is extended. As of February 14, 2006, the BOSS provided 737 estimates and has received 535 commitments. Sidewalk reconstruction has been completed at 127 of these locations. Construction will be initiated on the remaining 408 locations by June 30, 2006 and the specific locations are detailed on a summary table and included in the March 24, 2006 BOSS report and attached to the Council file.

After having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to note and file the March 24, 2006 BOSS report relative to the establishment of a voluntary City-wide sidewalk repair

program modeled after CD 2's "50/50 Sidewalk Repair Pilot Program" in FY 2005-06, inasmuch as this report is for information only and no Council action is required.

This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
