A RESOLUTION

OF THE

BOARD OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES

WHEREAS, the Church of Scientology has made a request to the City of Los Angeles (City) to install a private line telecommunications facility (Facility) which would encroach into that portion of the public rights-of-way in Los Angeles at North Bronson Avenue and Franklin Avenue, connecting buildings located at 1830 North Bronson Avenue, and 5930 Franklin Avenue, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 13.62, 13.14, and 13.15 of the City's Administrative Code (the Administrative Code), the approval and recommendation of this Board and the subsequent approval of the Los Angeles City Council is necessary to effect a grant of the City's permission to install such a Facility in the public right-of-way, and

WHEREAS, Section 13.62 of the Administrative Code requires that such permission be granted by way of an instrument denominated as a Franchise, and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that the public interest will not be harmed if such permission is granted subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the attached Franchise Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section Section 22.646(e)(2)(B) and (C) of the Administrative Code, this Board is to take official actions by resolution,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Information Technology Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles, that:

The Board hereby approves and recommends to the City Council that a Franchise in the Ordinance form attached hereto be granted to the Church of Scientology, which Franchise will permit the Church of Scientology to install and maintain a private line telecommunications Facility which would encroach into that portion of the public rights-of-way in North Bronson Avenue and Franklin Avenue, connecting buildings located at 1830 North Bronson Avenue and 5930 Franklin Avenue subject to the terms and conditions contained in the Franchise Ordinance.
