## **VERBAL MOTION**

I HEREBY MOVE that Council ADOPT the following recommendation of the City Administrative Officer SUBMITTED WITHOUT RECOMMENDATION by the Arts, Parks Health and Aging Committee (Item No. 21, CF 06-279) relative to an agreement for the operation and maintenance of the arcade at the Sherman Oaks Castle Park:

AUTHORIZE the President and Secretary of the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners to execute, the agreement with Butterfield Games, Inc. for the operation and maintenance of the arcade at the Sherman Oaks Castle Park, for a term of ten years with one five-year renewal option, subject to the terms and conditions of the lease between the City and the United States Army Corps of Engineers, subject to the approval of the City Attorney.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The CAO reports that the Butterfield Games, Inc. will pay the City 42.5 percent of gross receipts from the operation of the arcade at Sherman Oaks Castle Park. Revenues from this concession agreement will be deposited into the Department of Recreation and Parks operating funds. There is no additional impact on the General Fund. The recommendation above is in compliance with the City Financial Policies in that user charges and fees are set to support the full cost of operations for which the fees are charged.
