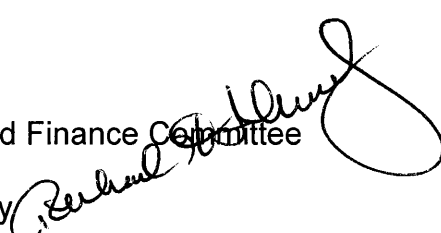

SUBJECT: **Outside Counsel Expenditures – Fiscal Year 2006-07

Attached please find a summary of Citywide Outside Counsel Expenditures for Fiscal Year 2006-07 as of March 31, 2007. Information is included for all City Departments regardless of funding source. Expenditure data is provided on a per contract basis as well.

Although our Office does not control the data related to Proprietary and special-funded departments, the deployment of new staff has assisted enormously in ensuring improved tracking and accuracy of data reported, enhanced bill review and faster payment for contractors.

At the behest of Councilmember Parks, we have included additional information to provide a more historical perspective to the data. We expect in coming reports to further refine the information provided to you today and look forward to continuing our work together to provide strong oversight for outside counsel and to continue the reduction of liability claims.
