Youth Speak! Collective is currently developing a community garden project at Roger Jessup Park in Pacoima. The organization has been given a commitment of funding on a matching basis over the next four years.

Sufficient funds are available in the Hansen Dam Environmental Awareness Fund which could be used for this purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council hereby RESOLVE that \$100,000 in the Hansen Dam Environmental Awareness Fund No. 43Q be utilized to fund any aspect of the community garden project by Youth Speak! Collective on the following condition: the organization shall be given the amount of \$25,000 per year for four years for a total not to exceed \$100,000, on a matching basis, i.e. Youth Speak Collective has to raise \$25,000 each year in order to receive a \$25,000 match from the City.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be directed to prepare the necessary documents and/or agreements with Youth Speak Collective, or any other agency or organization, as appropriate, in the above amount, for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality, if needed, and that the Councilmember of the District be authorized to execute such agreement or other documents on behalf of the City.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
