

Los Angeles County Sheriff's Deputy Juan Abel Escalante was shot to death outside of his parents home in Cypress Park, as he was leaving for work at the downtown Men's Central Jail. Witnesses said they saw a white, for-door vehicle approach Escalante shortly before gunfire erupted. Deputy Escalante, his wife, and their three children were living with his parents while preparing to purchase a home in Pomona. The detectives believe a reward may compel member of the public to provide information on the persons responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the

safety of the people of Los Angeles; therefore, it is appropriate for the City of Los Angeles to offer a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this crime.
