On the morning of Saturday, August 2, 2009, Los Angeles County Sheriff's Deputy Juan Abel Escalante was shot to death outside of his parents' home in Cypress Park, as he was leaving for work at the downtown Men's Central Jail. Witnesses said they saw a white, four-door vehicle approach Escalante shortly before gunfire erupted. Deputy Escalante, his wife, and their three children were living with his parents while preparing to purchase a home in Pomona. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, OCTOBER 11, 2017.


