Here is the text of the resolution:

"As it relates to the project commonly called the "Camerford Lofts Project," The Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council opposes the development as proposed by the development team. However, the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council supports the position taken by the City of Los Angeles Planning Commission during its recent meeting which occurred on Dec. 13, 2007 for the same reasons the City of Los Angeles Planning Commission opposed the proposed project. In addition, the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council encourages the City to take into account the cumulative negative impacts the proposed project will impose upon the community infrastructures and upon the local on-street parking, which should be resolved prior to granting any project on the proposed parcels."
