
Re: Council File No. 08-1846 – Property Address: 11345 Ventura Boulevard – Request for Continuance


To Whom it May Concern:

I am writing to express my concern that the business '*Platinum Live*' at 11345 Ventura Blvd, is requesting that the hard fought and necessary restrictions put on their establishment be lifted. The reasons restrictions were applied in the first place still exist.

I am a 18 year resident at 11244 Sunshine Terrace in Studio City., about 3 blocks from this venue. This club came to my attention simply because of the chaos it creates as patrons disperse in the early hours of the morning. Over the years I have heard the people and the music so loudly I thought there was a party on our street. The lack of parking has not only brought drunken revelers onto our dark residential street, but also created a dangerous traffic situation on an already accident-prone stretch of the Blvd. Double parking, valets and patrons darting across the street have made this a hazardous area that is sure to result in a mortal accident if it hasn't already. From my bedroom I have heard the police loudspeakers ordering cars that are blocking the road to move.

Existing restrictions were created to control this situation, and should not be lifted.
