

MOTION

On August 15, 2008, a Motion (Weiss – Rosendahl) was presented to the City Council stating that the Department of City Planning (Planning) would be downgrading Overland Avenue from a "Secondary Highway" to a "Collector Street" (C.F. 08-2225). The Motion also directed the Bureau of Engineering (Engineering) and Planning to stop requiring street widening on Overland Avenue until the re-designation of the street to a Collector Street. Engineering subsequently submitted a letter dated February 24, 2010 to the Planning and Land Use Committee reiterating the directions in the Motion. Engineering also clarified that it would require widening in compliance with Collector Street requirements along Overland Avenue, from Santa Monica Boulevard to La Grange Avenue. On March 9, 2010, an amending Motion to update the language in the original Motion was presented to the City Council and reiterated the proposed re-designation of this portion of Overland Avenue to a Collector Street and the directions to Engineering and Planning to stop requiring the widening of Overland Avenue between Pico Boulevard and Santa Monica Boulevard. Engineering subsequently required a condominium development project to widen a portion of Overland Avenue in accordance with Collector Street standards.

The Bureau of Street Services (BSS) has indicated that the estimated cost to complete the restoration of the portion of Overland Avenue to its original width with BSS staff and resources would be about \$43,609. Miscellaneous cash bonds (MCBs) within the Public Works Trust Fund (PWTF) deposited for similar types of street work within two miles of this Overland Avenue project area may be available to use for this project.

I THEREFORE MOVE that The Bureau of Engineering, with the assistance of the Board of Public Works, identify up to \$43,609 in funding from MCBs deposited within the PWTF for this project, between 1945 to 1949 Overland Avenue, and transfer those funds to the BSS for the completion of this project.

I FURTHER MOVE that the council, Bureau of Street Services with the concurrence of the Mayor authorize:

1. The Director of the Office of Accounting to transfer up to \$43,609 from various MCB accounts within the Public Works Trust Fund, Fund No. 834, Department No. 50, to the Bureau of Street Services, Fund No. 100, Department No. 86, Appropriation Unit No. 0001010;
2. The Director of BSS to utilize the transferred funds to complete the restoration of Overland Avenue, between 1945 to 1949 Overland Avenue, utilizing BSS staff and resources; and,
3. The Director of the Office of Accounting, or designee, to make technical corrections or clarifications that may be necessary to implement the intent of this motion.




