

COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR AND MEMBER, ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE, relative to a Sixth Amendment to an Agreement with Webcor | Obayashi | Lyles, a Joint Venture, for Phase 4 of the Silver Lake Reservoir Complex Storage Replacement Project/Headworks Reservoir Project.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. APPROVE the Department of Water and Power (DWP) proposed Resolution authorizing DWP to execute a Sixth Amendment to Agreement No. 47071-2 with Webcor | Obayashi | Lyles, a Joint Venture, extending the current agreement by four years, from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2029, for a total contract term of 18 years, and increasing the contract authority by \$18 million, from \$388 million to \$406 million to complete the Headworks Reservoir Restoration (Phase 4) of the Silver Lake Reservoir Complex Storage Replacement Project/Headworks Reservoir Project.
2. AUTHORIZE, upon proper certification, the Chief Accounting Employee, DWP, to direct and draw demands on the Water Revenue Fund over the term of the Amendment to the Agreement and accompanying Resolution.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer reports that approval of the proposed Resolution and Sixth Amendment to Agreement No. No. 47071-2 with Webcor | Obayashi | Lyles, a Joint Venture will have no impact on the City's General Fund. The Amendment will increase the not to exceed contract authority by \$18 million, from \$388 million to \$406 million. Funding is budgeted and available in the DWP Water Revenue Fund. The recommendations above comply with the DWP adopted Financial Policies.
